

GUIDELINES FOR DCAC SUMMER REC PROGRAM

- ❖ No Inappropriate Language – No Verbal Abuse – NO BULLYING
- ❖ No Hitting or Fighting Allowed- NO BULLYING
- ❖ ALL Participants (including directors and teen helpers) are expected to dress “appropriately” in comfortable clothes with modest coverage. If clothing is deemed inappropriate by the directors that person will be sent home for the day.
- ❖ No Stealing
- ❖ Being Destructive to Property or Equipment Will NOT Be Tolerated
- ❖ The Community Center and its Grounds will be left clean and uncluttered every day. Participants, Teen Helpers and Directors will be responsible for its DAILY upkeep.
- ❖ When A Child Is In Time Out No Other Child Should Be Bothering Him/Her
- ❖ Being Disrespectful To Other Children or Staff Will NOT Be Allowed
- ❖ Children will not be allowed to leave the premises without parents consent. DCAC Board and Summer Rec Directors will not be responsible for children leaving the premises without permission.
- ❖ Children will not be allowed back in the program for that day if they leave early (an exception being that they had their parent's permissions due to an appointment, etc.)
- ❖ Children will NOT be allowed on field trips without a signed permission slip.
- ❖ Directors will have all Registration Forms, Medical Release Forms, Permissions Slips, and a First Aid Kit in the possession on all field trips.
- ❖ Injury Reports, Incident Reports and Teen Conduct Reports will be filled out as warranted.
- ❖ Parents may contact a DCAC Board member with concerns and ALL Board Members will be notified.
- ❖ There will be a Director in attendance at all times.

DCAC reserves the right to change, omit or add guidelines as situations warrant.
